CRA Conference Group Self-Guided Hike Suggestions for July 24, 2024

The Snowbird summer trails map can be found [here](#) on the Snowbird website, or on the Snowbird app.

Beginner Hike:

Route: Observation Point Trail from the Peruvian Terrace, begins behind the Summer Activities inflatables.

Trail conditions: wide, asphalt surface with very minimal elevation change

Distance: 2 miles out and back

This trail has the added perk of signage sharing information about local plants, animals, human history and avalanche mitigation. Search “Snowbird Observation Point Trail” on All Trails for GPS locating

Advanced Hike:

Route: Peruvian Gulch Trail and Cirque Trail to the top of the tram, begins above the loading station for the Peruvian chairlift.

Trail conditions: steep switchbacks on single track, some gravel/dirt summer road and ridgeline exposure in the final stretch to the summit

Distance: 3.3 miles one way, 6.7 round trip

This trail is the most challenging single push we have. You do not need a tram ticket to ride the tram back down the mountain, so that is a great way to save your knees if you don't want to do the round trip hike. Search “Peruvian Gulch via Blackjack Trail” on All Trails for GPS locating.
