WHAT IS THE COMPUTING COMMUNITY CONSORTIUM

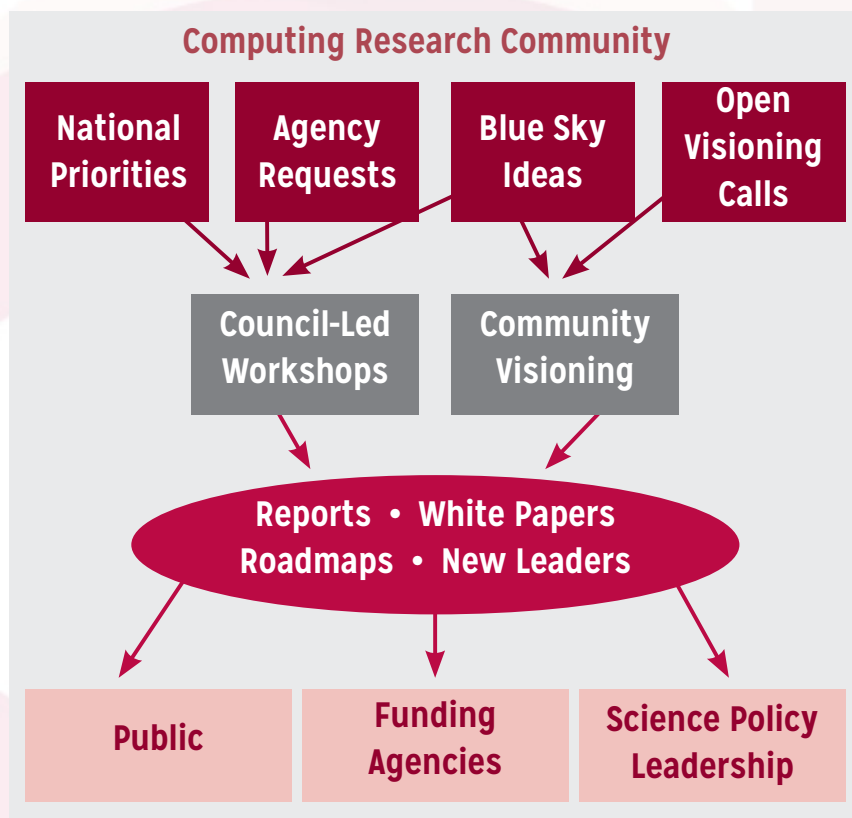
- Established in 2006 as a standing committee of the Computing Research Association

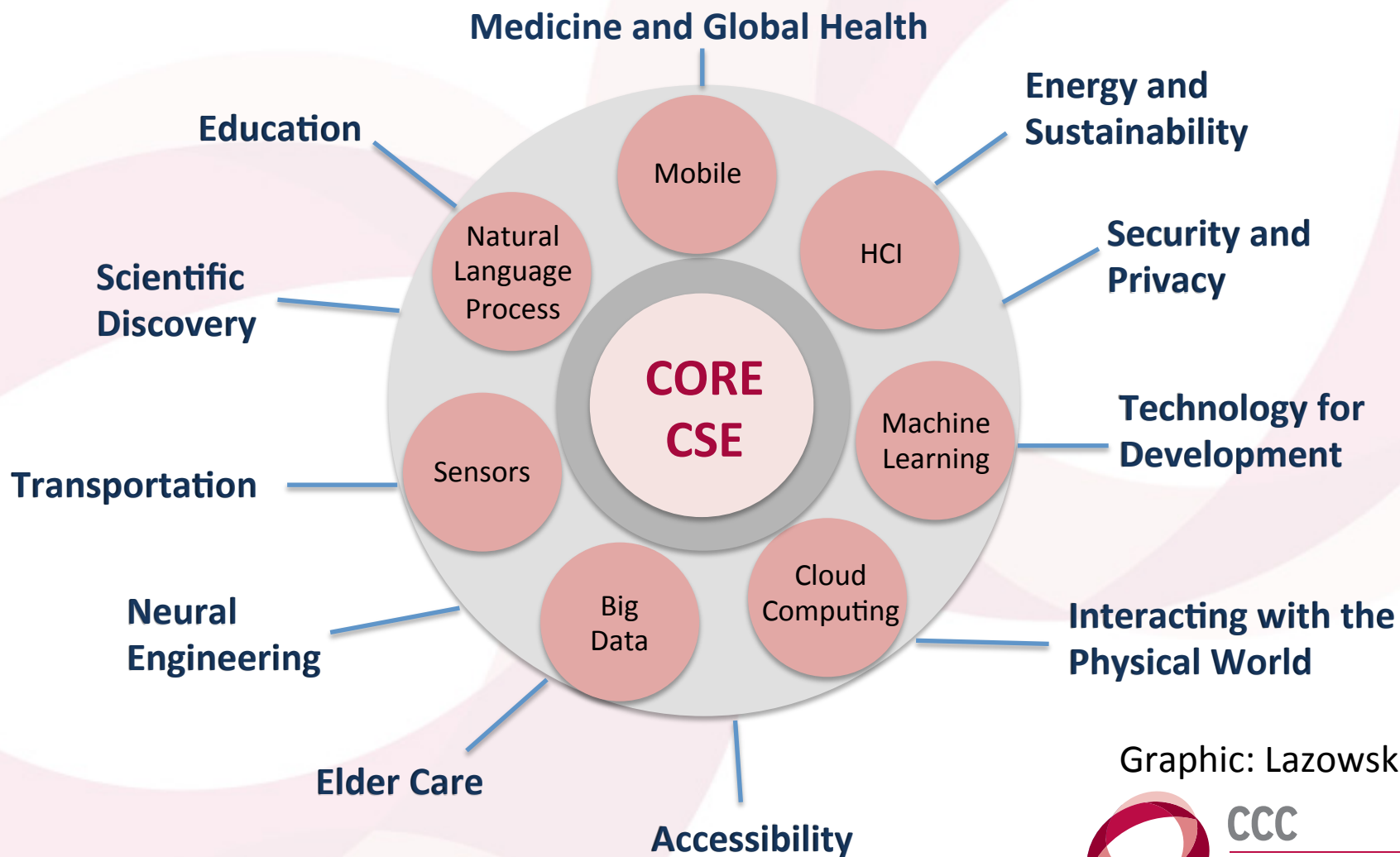
