- * Research is often collaborative, it is a social process.
- * Identify your roles in the Research Group.
 - o Identify both Primary and Secondary Roles.
 - Be Flexible! Understand that your roles within your Research Group may evolve as you progress.
- * Communication is key to effective collaboration of ideas.
 - O You will learn to communicate ideas by working in a Research Group.
- * Give credit where credit is due!
 - Stand up for your accomplishments, but also be generous with giving credit to others.
- *Your Research Group is the opportunity to apart of an environment that is supportive and advantageous for your research.
 - It is an opportunity to help yourself and others.

KEYS TO SUCCESFUL COMMUNICATION

- **❖** Have something to say and believe in it.
- Figure out how to organize your idea and proposal.
- Listen carefully to comments.
 - Remember you don't need to incorporate comments if you don't like them, but another viewpoint is helpful.
- Make sure to listen and understand a question before answering.



STEPS TO THE SOLUTION

If there is any conflict in your Research Group, identify the potential issue.

- All issues should be brought to the team leader sooner rather than later.
- Have a back up plan; just in case the Research Group falls apart.



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
