These positions are for candidates at the earliest stages of their careers and provide an option of a 1- to 2-year Khoury Research Fellow position, to allow candidates to ramp up their research programs before starting on the tenure track. The tenure home will reside in the Khoury College of Computer Sciences, with a potential joint appointment with another Northeastern College, to be determined in consultation with the person filling the position.
