This is an interdisciplinary search open to candidates with a Master's or doctoral degree in any relevant area – including but not limited to:

Data Science, Statistics, Economics, Computer Science, Mathematics, or Business – or a degree in another area and significant experience in quantitative methods.

Minimum Qualifications and Education:

- Master's degree or Ph.D. in a field related to data analytics or quantitative analysis (e.g., Data Science, Statistics, Economics, Computer Science, Mathematics, Business) or a Master's degree in another area with extensive training in quantitative methods.
- Knowledge of one or more programming languages, tools, and frameworks used in modern analytics work, such as R, the Python data science ecosystem, SQL, SAS, and Amazon Web Services. Experience with business analytics tools such as Excel and Tableau has value, but is not a substitute for this requirement.
- Willing and able to support a diverse student body and encourage the participation of women and other traditionally underrepresented groups in quantitative fields.
- Experience with, interest in, or appreciation of the ideals of liberal education.
- Interest in developing new classes for non-majors.
- Ability and desire to continually learn and maintain up-to-date skills in both software development and pedagogy.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Maintains professional and respectful interactions with students, staff, and faculty.
