

Tenured/Tenure-Track Positions in Computer Science

Position Description

NYU Shanghai is currently inviting applications for Tenured or Tenure-Track positions in Computer Science. The search is not restricted to any rank and outstanding candidates at all levels are encouraged to apply.

Terms of employment at <u>NYU Shanghai</u> are comparable to NYU New York and other U.S. institutions with respect to research start-up funds and compensation, and they include housing subsidies and educational subsidies for children. Faculty may in certain cases have the opportunity to spend time at NYU New York and other sites of the NYU Global Network, engaging in both research and teaching.

Qualifications

We seek candidates who have completed a Ph.D. in Computer Science or a closely related discipline. We invite applications from candidates in all areas and have a special interest in those with expertise broadly in Systems. We are especially interested in candidates pursuing systems-oriented research in Security and Privacy, Robotics, Distributed Computing, Data Analysis and Management, Computer Vision, Human-Computer Interaction (HCI), Programming Languages, and Computer Architecture.

Applicants should submit a cover letter, curriculum vitae, statement of research, statement of teaching interests, and at least one publication via Interfolio. Additionally, applicants will be prompted to enter the names and email addresses of at least three referees. Each referee will be contacted to upload a reference letter through Interfolio.

For full consideration applications should be received by **January 15, 2024**. Review of applications will begin on **December 1, 2023** and will continue until the position is filled.
