In addition to the minimum qualifications, it is preferred the candidate also have:

- Doctoral Degree (PhD or other) in Computer Science, Information Science, Information Technology, Information Systems or a closely related field
- Experience with various teaching and course development in various modalities (online, hybrid, face-to-face, HyFlex)
- Demonstrated ability to teach diverse populations
- Demonstrated ability to engage in scholarly activities
- Digital technology industry experience

- This is a full-time, tenure-track (10-month) appointment
- The salary range for Assistant Professor is \$55,000 - \$60,000.
