Applications from scholars who apply interdisciplinary perspectives across these fields to a variety of domains, including biology, computational social sciences, education, engineering, healthcare, mathematics, neuroscience, robotics, and virtual reality, among others.

The positions are part of a new initiative that aims to transform our understanding of human and artificial intelligence, centered around the new [Mind Brain Machine Quadrangle](#) and the [Luddy Artificial Intelligence Center](#). IU has long been an international leader in research on cognition across humans, animals, and artificial systems and how intelligence manifests

in embodied cognition. These hires build on existing strengths to position IU at the forefront of new research innovations in our understanding of human and animal cognition, the development of intelligent computing technologies, and the use of machine learning applied to a wide range of phenomena.
